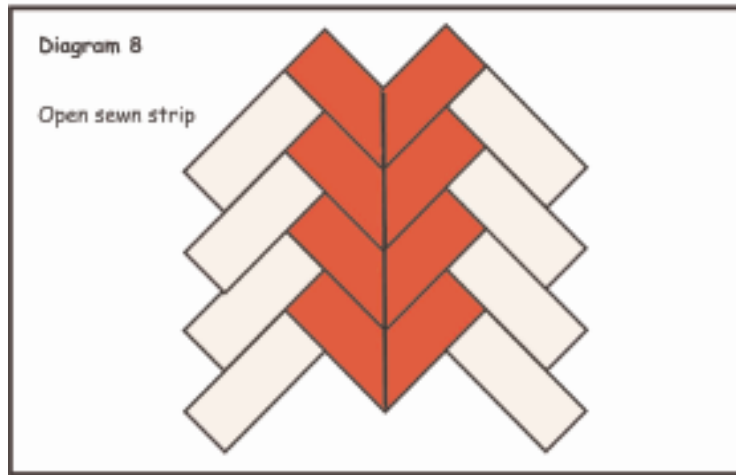
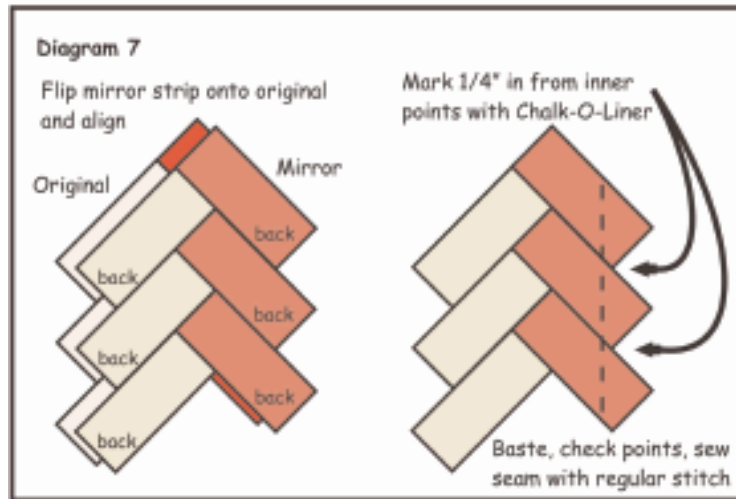


Regency Dandy Braid Designed by Gerald Roy

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Lap Quilt Approx. Size: 48" x 60"

Fabric Requirements:

Fat quarter of the entire line

1/2 yard of inner border fabric (cut 1-12")

2-1/2 yards of outer border fabric (cut 10")

Cut fat quarters in 2-1/2 inch strips

Cut these strips into 6" segments.

Using the photo for placement, layout the fabric in order starting from the bottom.

Piecing of this quilt is simple – just follow the diagrams supplied here.

Simple Braids:

Important Rule - when the braid pieces are the same length you must make a mirror image when creating the "second" strip. All strips must be made in "pairs."
